

Cool Tools Behavioral Lesson Plan

Universal Expectation: Respectful
Name of the Skill/Setting: Quiet Hallways

Purpose of the lesson/Why it's important:
Show respect for teachers and classmates.
Minimize distractions to learning.
Establish school-wide consistency and community.

Teaching Examples:
Be quiet when walking in the hallway.
Be quiet when taking a bathroom break or getting a drink.
Be quiet when going to your locker.

Kid Activities/Role-Plays:
Brainstorm ways to greet friends without talking or leaving the line (smile, finger waves, etc.)
Quietly walk to different locations in large and small groups.
Quietly put things into and take things out of lockers.
Quietly get a drink.
Try to walk through the hallway as quietly as a mouse.
Make and carry a classroom Quiet sign when walking through the hallways.
